The quiz where correct answers are just the beginning...

Welcome to The Connection Quiz, and thank you for trying our free version! This sample includes one complete round, giving you a chance to experience how the quiz works and discover what makes it different.

The Connection Quiz starts like any traditional quiz: teams answer questions across a variety of categories and compete to collect points by giving as many correct answers as possible. But the real challenge begins after the answers are revealed. Your team must look beyond the individual answers and discover the hidden connections between them.

A standard quiz consists of 4 rounds, with 8 questions per round. The questions are grouped into 2 series of 4 questions. The four answers within each series combined lead to 1 connecting word.

For example, 4 answers “Eiffel”, “Love”, “Louvre” and “Capital” lead to the connecting word “Paris”

You can decide to play the quiz with a bonus round. Teams can pick their ‘bonus round’ based on the question categories in that round. At the end of the quiz, all points scored in that round are doubled and added to the total score.

A Connection Quiz with 4 rounds typically takes 1.5 to 2 hour, depending on the speed of questioning and excluding time for extra connection game rounds.

Structure per quiz round & recommended scoring

A single Connection Quiz round consists of 2 series of 4 questions, so 8 questions in total per round. Each series gives 4 answers which lead to 1 connecting word. You score 1 point per correct answer and 1 point per correct connecting word

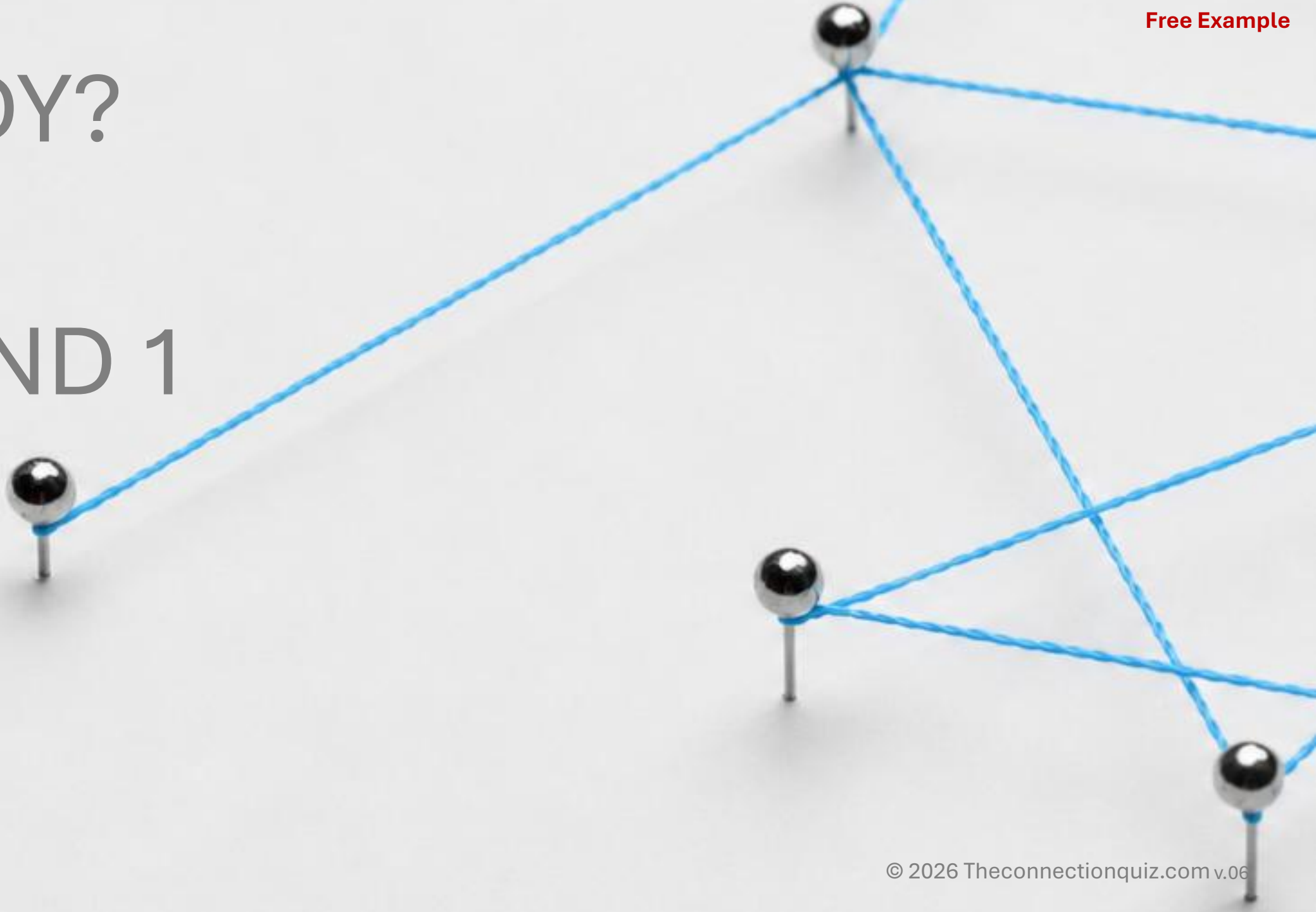
Consider adding a bonus twist: at the beginning of the quiz, each team chooses one round to double. At the end of the quiz, all points scored in that round are doubled and added to the total score

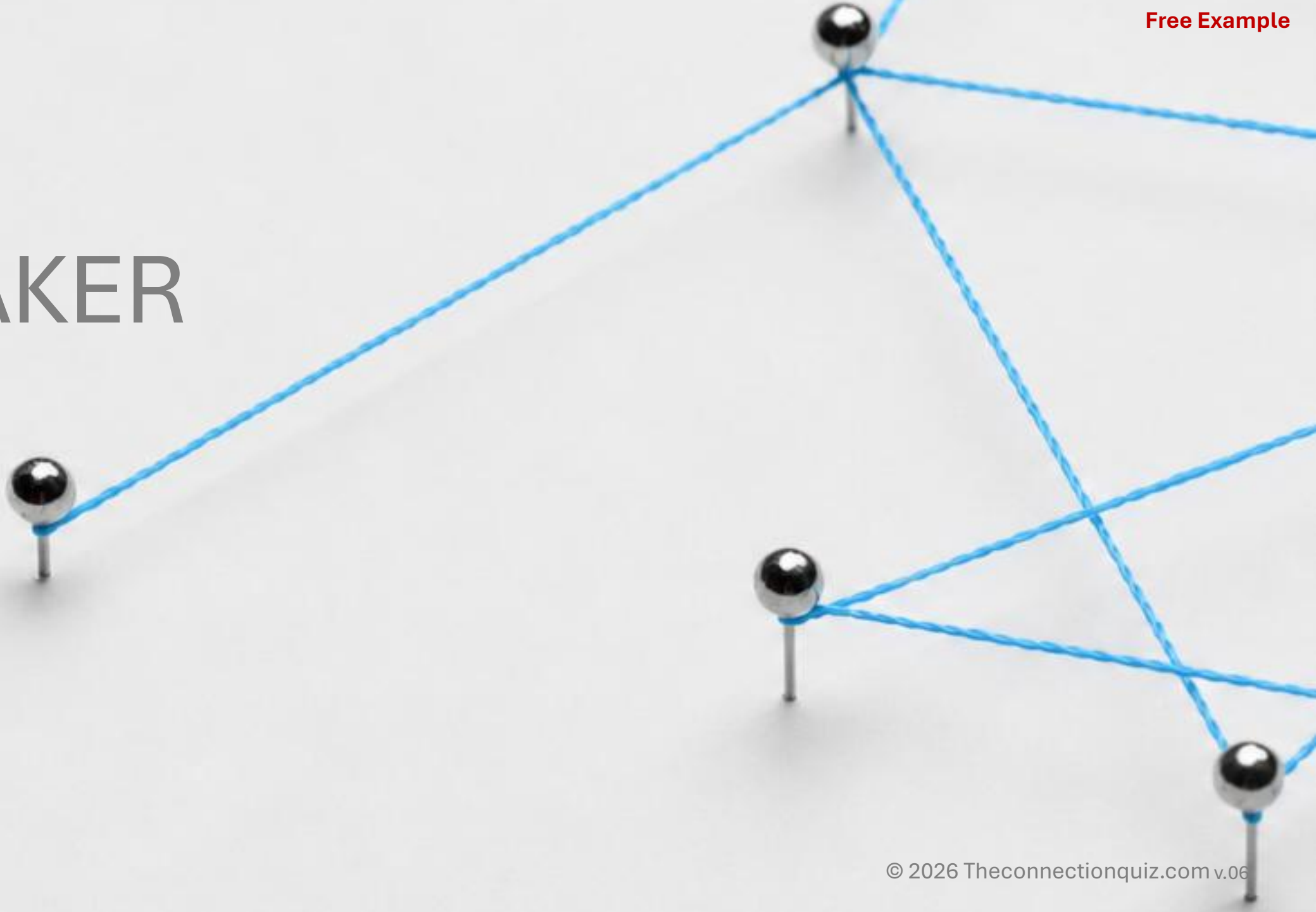
Shakira
